

## How to Make a Sock Snowman

### How to Make:

1. Use a funnel to fill white tube sock with rice. (You can also place the sock inside of a cup and roll the top over the cup's edge to create an easier opening to pour rice inside.)
2. Once you have a good amount of rice in the sock to make a happy snowman body, take a rubber band and tightly wrap to close the top of the sock.
3. Cut away excess fabric on the end of the sock (but do not cut too close to the rubber band or the rubber band will come off and your snowman's rice will spill out.) If you are worried about it coming undone, you can always add some hot glue to secure the top of the sock opening.
4. Take a second rubber band and roll it down the white tube sock filled with rice. This will make two round sections (like snowballs): a head and a body.
5. Add facial features to your snowman. You can use the orange felt for a nose and the black pom-pom balls for eyes. While you can use regular glue, note that hot glue will work faster and might be stronger. You can also draw the facial features on with sharpie.

### Ideas for How to Decorate:

- Using the colorful/patterned sock, cut off the toe portion of the sock, and place it around the snowman's head to make a winter hat.
- If you prefer a longer hat, you can take an open ended tube of sock, close off one end with a rubber band, and place the other end on the snowman's head.
- For either hat, you can attach a pom-pom to the hat if you want to embellish it.
- Tie a piece of fabric or ribbon around the snowman's neck to make a scarf.
- Take an open tube of colorful sock and secure it around the snowman's body if you want it to have a sweater.
- Hot-glue three buttons down the center of the bottom portion.
